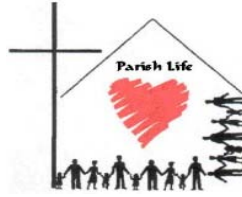

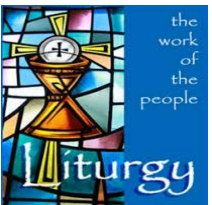


FALL BACK!

SO MANY WONDERS ON DIVINE LITURGY



There are so many wonderful things that happen during the Divine Liturgy. If you went to Liturgy every day of your life, you would still be discovering its wonders at the end of your life. There is nothing like the Liturgy. The Eucharist is another wonder we experience on Liturgy.

We believe that during the Liturgy, a simple piece of bread and a cup of wine are transformed into the Body and Blood of Jesus. That is amazing! It is amazing that God gives himself to us in this way. At Liturgy God gives himself to us completely in the Eucharist, and at Liturgy we give ourselves completely to him in prayer. Sometimes people say they are bored at Liturgy. Usually this is because they are not listening to what is going on or because they are not listening to what God saying to them. It is impossible to be bored at Liturgy if we are trying to listen the God’s voice. If we ever find Liturgy boring, it’s time for us to put more energy into our conversation with God. If we find Liturgy uninteresting, perhaps we need to learn more about what is actually happening. Everything that happens at Liturgy happens for a reason, and when we really know what is going on, it is fascinating. Sometimes it helps to have a prayer book, a small book that explains everything that is happening in the Divine Liturgy. It can be very helpful to follow along. Another way to make sure we don’t get bored at Liturgy is to sing all the songs and respond to all the prayers. When you participate in Liturgy you are in conversation with God. It is only when we stop participating that we get bored. Plus, when we talk with God, he tells us amazing things!

As we grow in wisdom we discover that the Divine Liturgy is the most amazing event on earth!

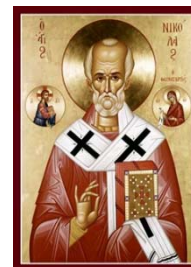


Mark Your Calendar for Saint Nicholas Day Social
